Eula Rae Ledbetter, 80 year-old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died Monday, December 20, 2004, at Siloam Springs Memorial Hospital. Born November 17, 1924 in Farmington, Arkansas she was the daughter of William Harvey Crowder and Lucy McKinley Crowder. She lived many years in the Bloomfield Community near Gentry, Arkansas. She was a riveter on the B24's for the defense department during World War II. She enjoyed poetry and wrote numerous poems.
