



## Floy Brashear

September 23, 1922 - December 26, 2004

Floy L. Brashear, 82 year-old resident of Kansas, Oklahoma, died December 26, 2004, at Siloam Springs Memorial Hospital, Siloam Springs, Arkansas after a short illness. Born September 23, 1922 in Rocky Ford, Oklahoma, she was the daughter of Earl Freeman and Mae Belle Strong Freeman Garrett. She lived in the Kansas, Twin Oaks area for 60 years and in the Tulsa area for 20 years. She was a cosmetology teacher. Floy was also one of the "Rosie the Riveters" during World War II and was of the Baptist faith.
