Floy Nadine Muehlberg, 83, of Fort Worth, Texas, died July 5, 2016, at St. John's Residential Care Home, Fort Worth, Texas. 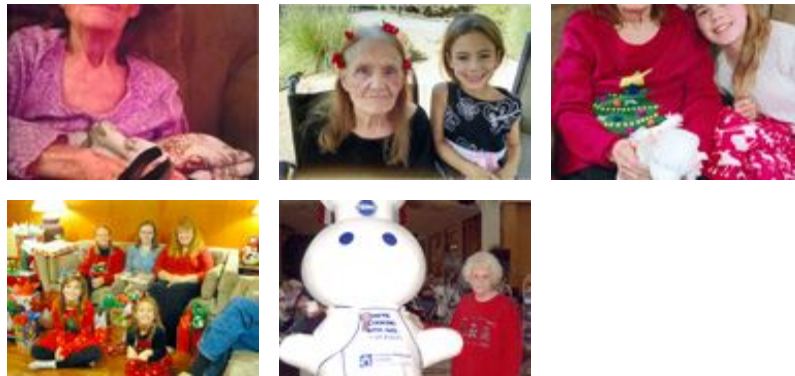
