Floyd Wayne Bearden, 65, of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died August 25, 2011, at Siloam Springs Memorial Hospital. Born November 27, 1945 in Bastrop, Louisiana, he was the son of Lucien Bearden and Juanita Jackson Bearden. He was an Air Force Veteran of the Vietnam War. He served in the Air Force from 1963 to 1980. Floyd married Marian G. Allen in Minden, Louisiana on March 30, 1980.
