



## Floyd Allen Young

February 23, 1944 - August 11, 2019

Floyd Allen Young, 75 year old resident of Colcord, Oklahoma, died on August 11, 2019 at Quail Ridge Living Center in West Siloam Springs, Oklahoma. Born on February 23, 1944 in Ada Valley, Arkansas, he was the son of Jeff Young and Leta Mash Young. Floyd graduated from Morrilton High School in Morrilton, Arkansas. He had multiple Bachelor's Degrees, including Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, and only lacked an Algebra class for his Nuclear Engineering. Floyd helped to build a power plant in North Platte, Nebraska, and stayed to work for Nebraska Public Power Department.

Floyd was preceded in death by his parents; two brothers, Leon Young and Billy Joe Flowers; and sister, Ruby Jewel Hitchcock.
