



## Forrest Moomey

February 18, 1916 - January 4, 2007

Forrest Vern Moomey, 90 year-old resident of Gentry, Arkansas, died January 4, 2007, at Siloam Springs Nursing And Rehab, Siloam Springs, Arkansas.
