September 15, 1916 - June 26, 2005

Dickie Dean, 88-year-old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died Sunday, June 26, 2005, at her home. Born September 15, 1916, in Horatio, Arkansas, she was the daughter of Dr. Richard C.
