July 25, 1916 - March 12, 2010

Frank Phillip Nash, 93, of Gentry, Arkansas, died March 12, 2010, at his home. Born July 25, 1916, in Canton, Texas, he was the son of Frank Bean Nash and Susie Ellen Taylor Nash. Frank was an Army veteran and was awarded the Purple Heart and the Bronze Star for his service during World War II. He moved to the Gentry area in 1972 from Wichita, Kansas. He was an auto mechanic. He then worked for Roadway Freight, from which he retired. He was a member of the Teamsters' Union of Wichita, Kansas. On July 17, 1943, he married Lorraine Vaughn in Fayetteville, Arkansas. He was preceded in death by one grandson, Jay Stephenson; one great grandson, Gunner Bromley; two brothers, Charlie Nash and Floyd Nash; and one sister Eva Lockhart. Survivors include his wife C. Lorraine Nash of the home; three daughters, Frances Stephenson of Mountainburg, Arkansas, Phillis Pace and husband Tom of Rudy, Arkansas, and Lori Smith and husband Kirk of Siloam Springs; seven grandchildren; twelve great grandchildren; one great great grandchild; one sister, Nona Mae Curtsinger of Farmington, Arkansas.
