July 3, 1944 - September 4, 2012

Gary Hays Dunlap, 68, of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died September 4, 2012, at Circle of Life Hospice, Springdale, Arkansas. Born July 3, 1944, in Prairie Grove, Arkansas, he was the son of Bill Bailey and Betty and Hurchel Dunlap. He was a lifelong resident of Northwest Arkansas, and a 1962 graduate of Siloam Springs High School.
