A memorial service will be held at 1:00 p.m., Saturday, October 13, 2018, at First Baptist Church, Gentry, Arkansas.

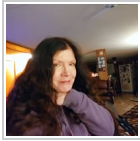

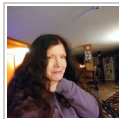
