Gladys Engel, 87-year-old resident of Moseley, Oklahoma, died Saturday, November 13, 2004, in Springdale, Arkansas. Born October 4, 1917, in Fay, Oklahoma, she was the daughter of August Masquelier and Bertie Leona Preston Masquelier. Mrs. Engel had lived in Moseley for 55 years, moving there from Corn, Oklahoma.
