



## Glenn Howard

December 12, 1919 - March 18, 2007

Glenn F. Howard, 87, of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died March 18, 2007, in Nacogdoches, Texas. Born December 12, 1919 in Siloam Springs, Arkansas, he was the son of Frank Howard and Mae Green Howard. He had been a resident of Nacogdoches for the last 1 1/2 years. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Siloam Springs, Arkansas. He served in the U.S. Army during WWII and had worked 44 years for the Pet Milk Corporation. Mr. Howard was also awarded the Silver Beaver Award by the Boy Scouts of America while serving as a Scout Master. He was preceded in death by his wife, Thelma Masters Howard in 2004; and one sister, Delora Blystone in March, 2007. Survivors include one son, Guy Howard and wife Brenda of Nacogdoches; and two granddaughters, Marinda and Janet Howard of Austin, Texas. Funeral services will be 2:00 p.m., Thursday, March 22, 2007, at Wasson Memorial Chapel, Siloam Springs, Arkansas, with Dr. Steve Abbott officiating. Burial will follow at Oak Hill Cemetery, Siloam Springs, Arkansas. Visitation will be 6:00 to 8:00 p.m., Wednesday, March 21, 2007, at Wasson Funeral Home.
