



## Gordon Hinrichs

December 20, 1909 - February 6, 2009

Gordon Charles Hinrichs, formerly of Gentry Arkansas, died at the age of 99 on February 6, 2009 in Carrollton, Georgia. He was born December 20, 1909, on the home farm near Pomeroy, Iowa to Gerhard and Christine (Swanson) Hinrichs. Prior to retiring to Gentry, Arkansas in 1979, he owned the Hinrichs Truck Line and Livestock Buying business in Ida Grove, Iowa for many years. He married Lorena Larae Bell of Des Moines, Iowa. They were members of the First United Methodist Church in Gentry, Arkansas.
