Harley Wilburn “Pete” Duncan, 77, of Decatur, Arkansas, went home to be with the Lord, after battling a long illness, on March 18, 2011, at Northwest Medical Center, Springdale, Arkansas. Born October 15, 1933, in Hiwasse, Arkansas, he was the son of James Blaine Duncan and Ellen Elizabeth Jameson Duncan. Pete was an Army Veteran of the Korean War. He was a lifetime resident of Decatur and was employed by Peterson Industries as a truck driver and dispatcher for 45 years, until his retirement in 2001. He married Virginia “Ginger” Kennedy on December 8, 1956, in Decatur, Arkansas. Pete was a member of the United Methodist Church, Decatur, Arkansas. He was an extremely hard worker, dedicated to providing for his family. He was a loving grandfather.
