Harold G. Johnson, 93 year-old resident of Watts, Oklahoma, died Friday, February 13, 2009, in Siloam Springs Memorial Hospital, Siloam Springs, Arkansas. Born April 14, 1915 in Brule, Nebraska, he was the son of Lorenzo Delmont Johnson and Luella Bell Slayton Johnson.
