



Harvey L. Hayes

May 11, 1926 - January 27, 2016

Harvey L. Hayes, 89 year old resident of Siloam Springs, died January 27, 2016 at Circle of Life Hospice in Legacy Village, Bentonville, Arkansas. Born May 11, 1926 in Alex, Oklahoma, he was the son of Rosco Logan Hayes and Stella Stidham. Harvey was a Navy Veteran of World War II. During WWII Harvey was a crew member aboard an amphibious attack transport, USS Tazewell (APA-209). On 1 April 1945, at 17 years of age he was coxswain of a landing craft deploying troops on the beach during the invasion of Okinawa. He worked for 27 years as a truck driver for Curran Feed Store in Gentry. Harvey married Rena Owens Stanhope on May 22, 2006 in Siloam Springs.

He is survived by his wife, Rena Hayes; one son, Jack Wynn Hayes of Tacoma, Washington; six stepchildren: Dennis Turner of Pea Ridge, Kathi Goff of Arvada, Colorado, Sandy Embry of Fresno, California, Charles Smiley of Oakdale, California, Sherry Smiley of Fresno, and Ron Stanhope of Siloam Springs, Arkansas; seventeen grandchildren; numerous great grandchildren; one great great grandchild and several nieces and nephews.

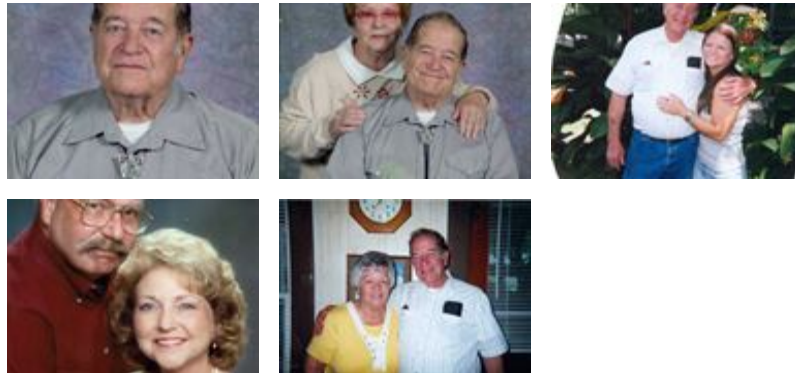
