May 15, 1923 - September 10, 2017

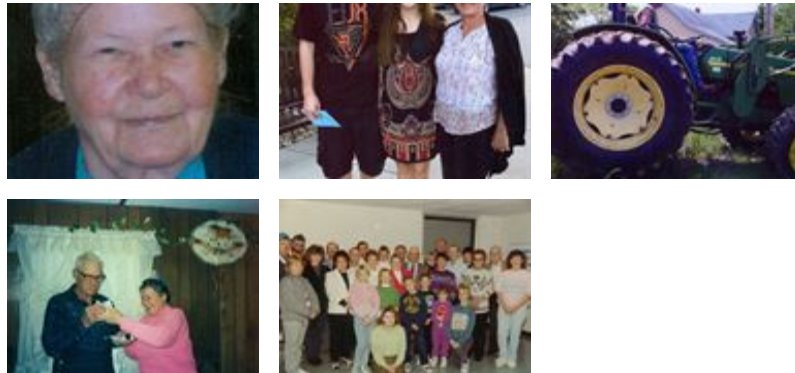
