



Henry Dilbeck

May 3, 1913 - December 29, 2008

Henry Adrian Dilbeck, 95-year-old longtime resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died December 29, 2008, at Washington Regional Medical Center, Fayetteville, Arkansas. Born May 3, 1913, in Montoya, New Mexico, he was the son of William Henry Dilbeck and Tabitha Ellen Talbert Dilbeck. He retired as a Railroad Mail Clerk with the United States Postal Service. Henry married Viva E. Trammell in the Church of God, on November 25, 1934, in Sand Springs, Oklahoma. They were married 72 years. He was a member of the First Christian Church, Gentry, Arkansas. Henry was preceded in death by his wife Viva, January 20, 2007; and eight brothers and sisters. Survivors include three sons, Howard Dilbeck and wife Ingrid of Atascadero, California, Loren Dilbeck and wife Shirley, and Henry Dilbeck and wife Bonnie, both of Siloam Springs, Arkansas; four daughters, Arlene Bradford, Annette Andrada, and Judy Carson, all of Siloam Springs, and Juanita Trammell and husband Ray of Fort Gibson, Oklahoma; 32 grandchildren, 45 great grandchildren; and one great great granddaughter.
