



Howard "Bryant" Austin

August 30, 1933 - April 8, 2025

Howard "Bryant" Austin, 91, of Siloam Springs AR, passed away on Tuesday April 8, 2025. He was born on August 30, 1933, in Maysville, Arkansas, to Thomas "Orville" Austin and Verda Athel (Jenkins) Austin.

Bryant was raised on the Ozark Springs Farm during the Great Depression and accepted Christ as his Savior at a young age. He studied engineering at the University of Arkansas and participated in a student exchange program in Turkey.

He served as a U.S. Marine Corps officer and retired as a Lieutenant Colonel. He went on to a 40-year global career with Caterpillar Inc. He rededicated his faith in the Jordan River during a trip to Israel in 2010.

In 1963, Bryant married Janet Schleper. They shared more than 62 years of marriage and raised three children in a home filled with faith and love.

He was preceded in death by his parents; brother, Dean (Jo) Austin; and sister, Verlene (Bill) Couch.

Bryant is survived by his wife, Janet; daughter Beth and John Schmidt of Chicago; son Will and Annette of Indianapolis; and son Craig and Louise of Austin, Texas. He was a proud grandfather to Eric, Kevin, and Amy Schmidt,

and Faith, Jonah, and Andrew Austin. He was also a loving uncle to the nieces and nephews of both his sister and brother.

A visitation is scheduled from 6:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. Friday, April 11, 2025, at Wasson Funeral Home. Funeral services are scheduled at 10:00 a.m. Saturday, April 12, 2025 at Covenant Church in Siloam Springs, Arkansas with a committal service to follow at Maysville, Arkansas.

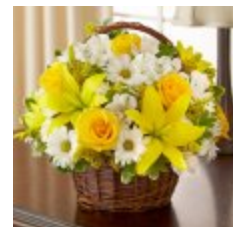
