



Imogene Veach Beals

June 5, 1921 - October 10, 2017

Imogene Veach Beals, 96, of Colcord, Oklahoma, died Tuesday, October 10, 2017, at home. Born July 5, 1921, in Trenton, Missouri, she was the daughter of Monroe Veach and Alta Brown Veach. Imogene's father Monroe was the original founder of Veach Saddlery Company of Trenton in 1919. The original business is still family owned and operated today.

Imogene spent most of her adult life in Tulsa, Oklahoma. She was married to Charley Beals in 1940 and they had one daughter Donna Kay. Charley died in December 1994.

Charley and Imogene were owners/operators of Veach Saddlery Company in Tulsa, from 1945-1984. She was a member and former board member of the Rodeo Historical Society in Oklahoma City at the National Cowboy & Western Heritage Museum, formerly known as the National Cowboy Hall of Fame.

Imogene was a past president of the Veitch National Historical Society and a noted rodeo historian, contributing to several books and publications on the subject. She was honored with the prestigious Tad Lucas award from the Rodeo Historical Society. Her late father and husband were previous inductees of the Society.

Survivors include her daughter, Donna Kay Clark and son-in-law Duke Clark; 3 grandsons, Derek Clark (Toni) of Colcord; Doug Clark (Linda) of Wayne, Oklahoma; Drew Clark (Darbi) of Colcord; 3 great grandsons, Chase Clark; Tyler Clark (Catherine); and Drake Clark; 3 great granddaughters, Chelsea Roberts (Reece); Darcy Good (Billy); and Dally Kay Clark. Two sisters, Peggy

Veach Robinson of Trenton, Missouri; Letty Veach McAlister of Checotah, Oklahoma; one sister-in-law, Edith Beals Letterman of Madison, Missouri and many nieces and nephews.

Preceded in death by her parents and husband along with two brothers, Billie Veach and Ben Veach and a sister, Mary Veach Cunningham.

A celebration of her life will be Saturday, October 28, 2017, 1:00 -4:00 PM. at Countryside Bible Church in Colcord.
