Irene Louise Tevebaugh, 93, of Gentry, Arkansas, died January 4, 2011, at Siloam Springs Nursing and Rehab, Siloam Springs, Arkansas. Born July 12 1917 in Peru, Kansas, she was the daughter of William W. Heald and Nora Brooks Heald. She was a lifelong resident of the Gentry area and worked at Twiggs Grocery Store and Barnetts Dairyette. She sang with a ladies' quartet for 50 years and was the pianist for the Methodist Church in Springtown for 60 years. Irene was a homemaker and seamstress, and a member of Springtown United Methodist Church in Springtown, Arkansas. Irene married Loyis Lee "Pete" Tevebaugh on July 12, 1935.
