



Jack Williamson

January 26, 1926 - February 15, 2007

Dr. Jack Urban Williamson, 81 year-old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died February 15, 2007, at Siloam Springs Memorial Hospital, Siloam Springs, Arkansas. Born January 26, 1926 in Fremont, Ohio, he was the son of Harold Urban Williamson and Hazel Mathews Williamson. He was an Air Force Veteran of World War II. He received his Bachelor's Degree at Ohio State University, his Master's Degree at Miami of Ohio, and his Doctorate from Ohio State University, where he taught while attending school. He taught Education classes at Arizona State University for three years. In 1967, he moved to Fayetteville, Arkansas, where he was a Professor of Education and the Chairman of Secondary Education Department, until his retirement in 1988. He was the Director of the University of Athens in Athens, Greece, from 1977 through 1987. He married Hennie Sipsma on September 19, 1948, in Fremont, Ohio. He was a stamp collector and loved to travel. Dr. Williamson was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church, Fayetteville, Arkansas. Survivors include his wife of 58 years, Hennie, of the home; one son, Steve Williamson and wife Mary of Fort Smith, Arkansas; one daughter, Sandra Williamson Thompson and husband Bob of Siloam Springs, Arkansas; three grandsons, Mike Williamson and Chris Williamson, both of Fort Smith, Arkansas, and Lee Thompson of Siloam Springs, Arkansas; two granddaughters, Jenny Lincks of Fort Smith, Arkansas, and Mercedes Thompson of Siloam Springs, Arkansas; 6 great grandchildren; and one brother, Bob Williamson and wife Barb of Fremont, Ohio. Funeral services

will be 10:00 a.m., Tuesday, February 20, 2007, at Wasson Memorial Chapel, Siloam Springs, with Rev. Roger Schoolcraft officiating. Burial will follow at Oak Hill Cemetery, Siloam Springs, Arkansas.
