James Orville Holland, 72, of Gravette, Arkansas, died July 9, 2022, at Ozarks Community Hospital. He was born September 27, 1949, in St. Joseph, Missouri, the son of Orville A. and Fern (Tittsworth) Holland. He was a 1967 graduate of Easton (MO.) High School and held an associate degree in Electrical Engineering from Johnson County Community College in Kansas City, MO.
