



## James "J.G." Taylor

November 26, 1927 - January 6, 2013

James "J.G." Gerrain Taylor, 85 year-old resident of Gentry, Arkansas, died January 6, 2013 at Circle of Life Hospice, Springdale, Arkansas. Born November 26, 1927 in Rector, Arkansas, he was the son of Hubert Taylor and Blanche Johnson Taylor. J.G. married Ella Crowson on May 28, 1949 in Piggott, Arkansas.
