He had a special love of horses and continued to have them around later in life too. Most recently, he enjoyed driving his Mini Horse Buttercup pulling his cart.

Everyone who knew Jerry knew about his handcrafted canes. Jerry made

some amazing ones for sure, and many were customized for very special people. Jerry always carried a few around with him because they brought him, and others, great joy. He would never run across a Veteran and not offer them one of his canes as a thank you for serving our country. A beautiful sentiment for sure.
