October 4, 1942 - September 1, 2006

Jerry Dale Harwell, 63 year-old resident of Highfill, Arkansas, died September 1, 2006, at his residence. Born October 4, 1942 in Boothe, Arkansas, he was the son of Gerald Duane and Nadine Trotter. He was a graduate of Mansfield High School in 1961. He moved to Highfill, Arkansas in 1966. He worked as a mechanic for his own business.
