John Price Bishop, 87 year old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died on August 11, 2019 at Washington Regional Medical Center in Fayetteville, Arkansas. John was born on April 12, 1932 in Mariaville, Nebraska, to Donald Archibald Bishop and Edna Pearl Brown Bishop. He joined the United States Air Force out of high school and served during the Korean War. John met Alice Foster while both were serving in the Air Force, and they were married on September 1, 1951 in Pocahontas, Arkansas. They moved to Siloam Springs in 1958 and he worked as a farmer, raising cattle and chickens, cutting hay, and operating a dairy.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Alice Bishop; parents, Donald and Edna Bishop; sister, Faye Johnson; brother, Joe Bishop; and great grandson, Quentin Thompson.

He is survived by four children: Pamela Phipps and husband Van of Siloam Springs, John F. Bishop and wife Marcia of Siloam Springs, Robin S. Bishop and wife Judy of Maysville, Arkansas, and Sandy Johnson and husband Joe of Siloam Springs; nine grandchildren, sixteen great grandchildren with one on the way; a great great grandchild on the way; and a brother, Jim Bishop of Colcord, Oklahoma.
