John Brown, 33 of Fort Bragg, Fayetteville, North Carolina, formerly of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died August 6, 2011, in the line of duty in Afghanistan. Born November 3, 1977, in Sacramento, California, he was the son of Dan Brown and Elizabeth Newlun. John grew up in Siloam Springs and was a 1996 graduate of Siloam Springs High School. He also attended John Brown University. Sergeant Brown was in the United States Air Force serving as a Pararescueman (PJ) assigned to the 24th Special Tactics Squadron, 724th Special Tactic Group, Air Force Special Operations Command, Pope Field, North Carolina.
