Johnny Michael Stonecipher, 71, of Kansas, Oklahoma passed away at his home September 29th, 2023 surrounded by loving family. 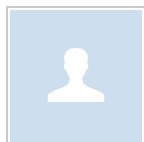

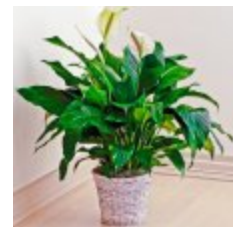
