Jordan Aaron Corley, 14-year-old resident of Watts, Oklahoma, died March 19, 2008, as the result of injuries sustained in an automobile accident in Watts. Born May 17, 1993, in Ft. Smith, Arkansas, he was the son of Billy Fuller and Dixie Bolin. He had been a resident of Watts the past 5 years and was a former resident of Hackett, Arkansas. He was an eighth-grade student at Watts Junior High School where he was a member of the football team. He enjoyed hunting and fishing.
