July 10, 1941 - July 29, 2018

Joseph "Joe" Thomas Smith, 77 year old resident of Gentry, Arkansas, died on July 29, 2018 at his home. Born on July 10, 1941 in Titusville, Florida, he was the son of Aulcie Smith and Augusta McAbee Smith. Joe moved to the Cherokee City area in the early 1950's. 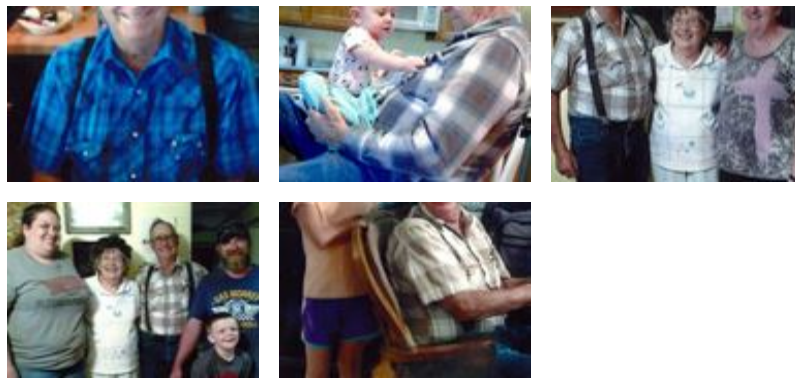
