Judy Jones, 85 year-old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died February 14, 2006, at Regency Hospital, Springdale, Arkansas. Born October 27, 1920 in Lane, Oklahoma, she was the daughter of Henry Travis Rounsaville and Edna Goldie Eastridge Rounsaville. She was raised in Lorenzo, Texas, graduated from Lorenzo High School and Draughons School of Business, Lubbock, Texas. She married Hollis Jones in Lubbock, Texas in 1940. She moved to the community in 1951 and lived on a poultry farm in the Decatur/Gravette area. She was an executive secretary for Peterson Industries for 24 years and was actively involved in dancing, bowling, bridge club, and enjoyed gardening, traveling, and family activities. Judy was a member of the Decatur Methodist Church, Decatur, Arkansas. Jones and wife Betty, of Tulsa, Oklahoma; two grandsons, Karl Jones of Washington D.C., and Michael Jones, of Tulsa, Oklahoma.
