Just 34 minutes after coming into the world, Julius Demetri (J.D.) passed away peacefully in his Daddy's arms while his Pastor Tim Estes prayed over them at UAMS in Little Rock, AR. During that fleeting time, he touched many lives and was loved by all who met him and followed his journey.

Born six weeks early and weighing only 5 lbs 0 oz and 18 ½" in length. J.D. was still able to show and be shown love. He was deeply loved by his parents and siblings. He had soft light red hair, the softest skin his family had ever felt and the purest smell they have ever smelt. Julius was diagnosed with Trisomy 13. His family refused to let that define the life he would have. They chose to give him life and show him love no matter how much time they had with him.
