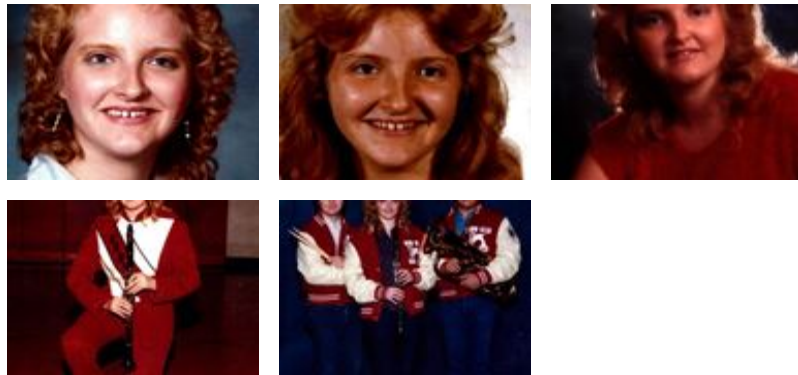

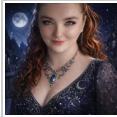

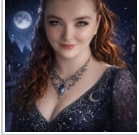

3rd was when my friend/ex-boyfriend Dusty had passed/went missing. I called her crying when none of us could find him. She talked me through it. She even did what she could to help. She would call me checking on me.

My mother growing up was my best friend. She always made sure that no matter what us kids knew she loved us and was proud of us. She never made us once feel like we couldn't do something. She made sure to be there for me no matter what. When my depression got to me she was there.

I promise mom. No matter what I won't let my depression get to me. Adam, dad and I will keep each other going. We will be there for Nani, your sisters and brother. Kayla and I will stay close. We will be there for each other and take care of each other. Cliffy too. It will be hard but we will take care of each other and we will be okay. We love you so much and miss you every day your gone.
