Kenneth L. Crain, 94 year old resident of Owasso, Oklahoma, died September 21, 2020 at Bailey Medical Center in Owasso, Oklahoma. He was born on January 21, 1926 in Colcord, Oklahoma, to William Andrew Crain and Lyda V. Storts Crain. Kenneth joined the United States Navy after graduating high school and served in World War II.
