



Kenneth Dixon

November 24, 1943 - February 4, 2010

Kenneth Ray Dixon, 66, of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died February 4, 2010, at his home after a 10 year battle with Non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma. Born Thanksgiving Day, November 24, 1943, in Siloam Springs, Arkansas, he was the son of Henry Dixon and Mabel Virginia Elrod Dixon. He was 1962 graduate of Siloam Springs High School and attended Arkansas Tech and John Brown University. He was an area poultry farmer, receiving the Jaycee's Outstanding Young Farmer Award in 1967, and the Arkansas Poultry Federation's Turkey Producer of the Year in 1979. He was a former member and officer of the Siloam Springs School Board, serving 16 years, and had also been active in the local Band Boosters, FFA Alumni Association. He was a board member of The Tired Iron Of The Ozarks, and also served on the Benton County FHA Loan Board. He was preceded in death by his parents, and one brother, Henry Dixon, Jr. Survivors include his wife Carole of the home; two sons, Mark Ray Dixon and wife Julie and Kevin Dale Dixon and wife Anissa, all of Siloam Springs, Arkansas; grandchildren, Halle Dixon and Chase Dixon of Siloam Springs; one brother, Thomas Dixon and wife Alice of Springfield, Conway County, Arkansas; one sister-in-law, Viola Dixon of Siloam Springs, Arkansas; three aunts, Florence Johnson of Wagner, Oklahoma, Imogene Elrod of Edmond, Oklahoma, and Francis Hayes of Checotah, Oklahoma; and numerous nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends. Graveside services will be 3:00 p.m., Sunday, February 7, 2010, at Oak Hill Cemetery, Siloam Springs, Arkansas, with Louie Thomas officiating. Visitation
