Larry Lee Bishop, 53 year-old resident of Cherokee City Community, Arkansas, died November 26, 2005, at his residence. Born November 9, 1952 in Siloam Springs, Arkansas, he was the son of Bill Bishop and Lorene Lewellen Bishop.
