Larry "Von" LaVaughn Fields, 58 of Siloam Springs, Arkansas died Wednesday October 26, at Circle of Life Hospice in Springdale. He was born October 29, 1952 at Siloam Springs to Troy Allen Fields and Mary Frances Shackelford Fields. He graduated from Gentry High School in 1970. Larry was a commercial artist. He worked for Phillip's Litho of Springdale before moving to Washington State where he lived for the next 22 years before moving back to Siloam Springs 12 years ago.
