Larry Gene Vaughn, 59, of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died May 9, 2009, at Circle of Life Hospice House, Springdale, Arkansas, after a short battle with cancer. Born September 2, 1949 in Kansas City, Missouri, he was the son of Thomas and Donna Mae Tippins Vaughn. It’s hard for me to explain how such strong friendships are made in military service but I still count both Larry (and Terry) among my very good friends. I am proud to have known them both.
