September 14, 1931 - July 5, 2014

Lauralee Robeson, 82 year old resident of Gentry, Arkansas, died on July 5, 2014 at her home. She was born September 14, 1931 in Cando, North Dakota to Ray Litsey and Inger Urness Litsey. Lauralee married Vernon "Martin" Robeson on June 30, 1957 in Wahpeton, North Dakota. She worked as an elementary school teacher for 49 years, teaching in North Dakota, Arkansas, California and Texas. Lauralee was awarded the Zapara Award for Teacher of the Year, while teaching in Texas. She also served as a missionary in Zambia, Africa for eight years.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, four brothers and three sisters.

She is survived by her children: Bruce Robeson and wife Mardel of Gentry, Janet Edelbach and husband Gene of Redlands, California, and David Robeson and wife Elizabeth of Loma Linda, California; seven grandchildren: Celeste, Chelsea, Zachary, Ryan, Corbin, Kristen and Bryston; and one sister, Vivian Johnson of Fargo, North Dakota.
