May 1, 1938 - June 1, 2005

Levon Dee Winningham, 67 year-old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died June 1, 2005, at Siloam Springs Nursing and Rehab, Siloam Springs, Arkansas. Born May 1, 1938 in Bradford, Arkansas, he was the son of Cleo Winningham and Lola Goad Winningham.
