Lorena La Rae (Billie) Bell Hinrichs 97, formerly of Gentry, AR died June 27, 2014, in Newnan, GA. She was born July 23, 1916, in Almitz, (Lucas County) IA to Andrew and Cora Bell. She graduated from Chariton High School in Chariton, IA.

After marrying Gordon Hinrichs in 1958 she moved to Battle Creek, IA where Billie was active in 4H for many years, a member of the First Presbyterian Church, Eastern Star and other town organizations.

In 1978 they "retired" to Gentry, AR where Billie and Gordon raised feeder pigs, then calves, then rabbits and finally sheep. The sheep were much sought after for 4H projects. Finally in 1984 they moved to town. In Gentry, Billie was an active member of the First Methodist Church, Eastern Star and other organizations.

Survivors include daughter Sherry Schmidt and husband Mark of Newnan, GA and a Sister Betty Stansbury and husband Bob of Surprise, AR and many nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her husband Gordon Charles Hinrichs, two Brothers Andy Bell, Vincent (Bob) Bell and two Sisters Georgia Lang, Marjorie Wood.

Services will be held at 11:00 AM at the First United Methodist Church, Gentry. Burial will follow at the Gentry Cemetery.
