Loretta Ilene Millsap, 84 of Gentry, Arkansas died November 7, 2020 at Washington Regional Medical Center, Fayetteville, Arkansas. Loretta was born April 20, 1936 in Springdale, Arkansas to Frank Parsley and Corene Fields Parsley. She married Walter David Millsap on December 17, 1955. Loretta graduated college with a master's degree and she worked as a school librarian for 31 years and as a teacher. She also was a Sunday school teacher, an avid Pioneer fan, and part of the Gideon International organization. Loretta hosted foreign exchange students, was a very selfless person always putting God first, family second, others then herself, but she was known throughout Gentry for her homemade cinnamon rolls.

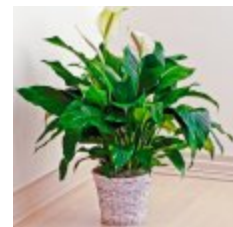
