June 18, 1949 - August 20, 2005

Louis Dean Littrell, 56 year-old resident of Gentry, Arkansas, died unexpectedly August 20, 2005, at Washington Regional Hospital, Fayetteville, Arkansas. He was born June 18, 1949, in Dayton, Washington. He was the son of Joba Allen Littrell and Esther Mariah Powell Littrell. Louis was an Army Veteran of the Vietnam War. He has lived in the area since 1977, and was co-owner of Gentry Poly Specialties and was the owner of Gentry Packaging. He was a deacon and a Pathfinder Leader at the Gentry Seventh Day Adventist Church in Gentry, Arkansas. Louis married Sherry Faye Hobbs on June 1, 1970 in Omaha, Nebraska. Louis's family donated seven of his organs including his heart, which was donated to a relative. Survivors include his mother Esther Littrell of Mountain Grove, Missouri; his wife Sherry of the home; one son, Jeremy Dean Littrell of Beaverton, Oregon; three daughters, Tammy Marie Rickard and husband Dan of Watertown, South Dakota, Candy Nicole Hausherr and husband Jason of Gentry, Arkansas, and Amanda Dawn Littrell of Gentry, Arkansas; two grandchildren, Landon and Alexandria Rickard, both of Watertown, South Dakota; one brother, David Littrell and wife Nancy of Norwood, Missouri; two sisters, Jeanie Maddox and husband Bill of Norwood, Missouri, and Vera Hart and husband Harold of Lake Worth, Florida. Funeral services will be conducted at 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, August 24, 2005, at the Gentry Seventh Day Adventist Church, Gentry, Arkansas, with Pastor Steve Evenson officiating. Burial will follow at Gentry Cemetery, Gentry, Arkansas. Viewing hours will be 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Tuesday,
