Loyd Anderson, 77-year-old resident of Moseley, Oklahoma, died Saturday, May 24, 2008, in Rogers, Arkansas. Born September 5, 1930, in Delaware County, Oklahoma, he was the son of Raymond Albert Anderson and Hazel Marie Kettleman Anderson. Loyd had lived in the Moseley Prairie area all of his life.
