



## Lucile McVay

January 17, 1919 - July 22, 2009

Lucile Dees McVay, 90, of Cave Springs, Arkansas, died July 22, 2009, at Heritage Park Nursing Center, Rogers, Arkansas. Born January 17, 1919 in Savoy, Arkansas, she was the daughter of Ed Dees and Nannie Clouse Dees. She earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Music Education at Northeastern College, Tahlequah, Oklahoma, and a Master of Music Education from the University of Oklahoma. She was director and teacher of music in the schools at Nowata, Oklahoma for nine years. She was a member of Lakeview Baptist Church, Cave Springs, Arkansas, where she was a teacher and pianist. She was a member of "Teller of Tales", Shiloh Museum in Springdale. She wrote many stories and poems, especially about an Aunt Fredonia, of Coon Holler, Arkansas. She was preceded in death by her husband William Ray McVay and three brothers. Survivors include two nephews, Terry Dees of Hannibal, Missouri and Kerwin Dees, of Siloam Springs, Arkansas; and one niece, Judy Graham of Springdale, Arkansas. Funeral services will be 2:00 p.m., Monday, July 27, 2009, at Lakeview Baptist Church, Cave Springs, Arkansas, with Rev. Pat Robinson officiating. Burial will follow at Elm Springs Cemetery, Elm Springs, Arkansas. Visitation will be 1:00 to 2:00 p.m., prior to the service at Lakeview Baptist Church.
