



## Lynda Sue Dalrymple

Lynda Sue Dalrymple passed from this life on Saturday, April 26, 2014. She was born October 6, 1945 in Jay, Oklahoma to Glenn and Fannie (Earp) Payton. She graduated from Jay High School in 1963 and Northeastern State University in Tahlequah, Oklahoma. Lynda retired after 38 years as an elementary school teacher in Siloam Springs. She also lived and taught in Honolulu, Hawaii and Riyadh, Saudi Arabia. She was a member of the Eastgate Church of Christ. Lynda married Gerald "Jack" Dalrymple on July 10, 1965.

She was preceded in death by her husband Jack on December 31, 2011. Lynda was also preceded in death by her parents in 2008.
