Lyndle James Taylor, 87 year old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died February 6, 2018, Siloam Springs Regional Medical Center, Siloam Springs, Arkansas. Born September 27, 1930, in Time, Illinois, he was the son of Arthur V. Taylor and Ethel McGlone Taylor. Lyndle served our country during the Korean War and was a Southern Baptist minister for several churches including Big Cabin Baptist, in Big Cabin, Oklahoma, Rocky Branch Baptist, in Rogers, Arkansas and Westside Baptist in Colcord, Oklahoma He married Jewel Vest on May 29, 2016 and was a member of Harvard Ave. Baptist Church, Siloam Springs, Arkansas.

Lyndle was preceded in death by his parents, his first wife Jacquelyn, son Lyndle, Jr , two sisters and one brother.

Survivors include his wife Jewel of the home; daughters Kim Taylor of Vinita, Oklahoma and Kay Peters and husband Todd of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma; son Mark Taylor of Lowell, Arkansas; 8 grandchildren and 10 great grandchildren.

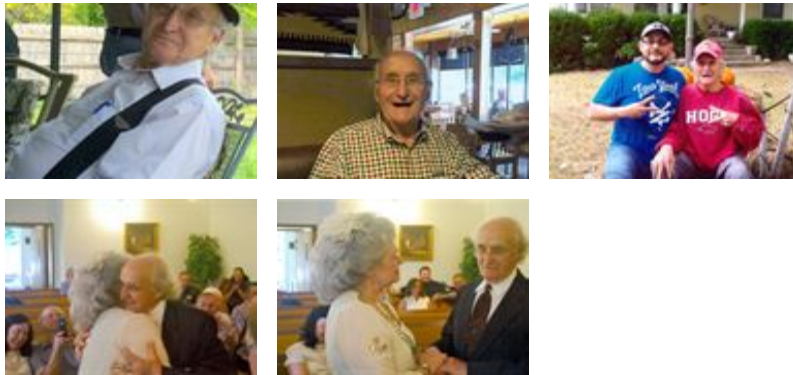
