



## Mamie Breese

March 7, 1909 - October 17, 2010

Mamie lone Breese, 101 year-old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died October 17, 2010 at Siloam Springs Nursing and Rehab. Until shortly before the time of her death, she had lived in her own home. Born March 7, 1909 in Catoosa, Oklahoma, she was the daughter of Harry F. Klahr and Emma Wyckoff Klahr. Mamie married R.O. "Jack" Breese in 1927. She was the youngest of nine children and grew up in the Owasso, Oklahoma area. She and her husband moved to Siloam Springs from Tulsa in 1946, where he established the Standard Auto Supply business which he co-owned. Mamie was a devoted wife, mother, homemaker, grandmother and friend; who was known for her expert dressmaking, pie baking and skill at crochet. She was preceded in death by her husband of 68 years, Jack Breese and one son-in-law, J.D. Moon. Survivors include two daughters, Peggy Moon of Kennedale, Texas and Ruth Ann Price and husband Jerry of Siloam Springs; three sons, Bill E. Breese and wife Phyllis of Owasso, Oklahoma, C.F. "Nick" Breese and wife Jo Ann of Owasso, and James L. Breese and wife Cathy of Lake Forest, California; 18 grandchildren and more than 70 great grandchildren and great great grandchildren; and a multitude of friends. Funeral services will be 10:00 am, Wednesday, October 20, 2010 at First Assembly Of God Church, Siloam Springs, Arkansas with Pastor Gary Wheat officiating.
