June 26, 1918 - May 8, 2014

Margaret Euphama Dunlap Hall, 95 year old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died on May 8, 2014 at Siloam Springs Regional Hospital. She was born to Ora Farley Dunlap and Evert N. Dunlap on June 26, 1918. She married Lewis J. Hall on June 1, 1938. Euphama was a charter member of Harvard Avenue Baptist Church, Siloam Springs, and was attending New Life Church in Siloam Springs. She attended high school in Watts, Oklahoma riding her horse to her Aunt Kate's in Watts and walking on to school with her cousins Velma and Dollie. She was a homemaker with a passion for her grandkids and her jobs. She sold Stanley Home Products and then joined the JC Penney Co in 1964, where she worked until it closed. Euphama was a volunteer at the Manna Center.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Lewis Hall; one daughter, Sharon Blankenship; her parents; and one grandson, James Robert.

She is survived by one son, Alan Hall and wife Amanda of Vinita, Oklahoma; four grandchildren, Dawna, Karisha, Craig and wife Cynthia, and Katie; five great grandchildren, Lacy and husband Mark, Tyler, Justin, Shaley, and Trace; three great great grandchildren, Connor, Maddie-Kaye and Easton.
